## ELK RIDGE EMERGENCIES



### Structure Fire

Lakeland & District Fire Department (LDFD) will respond  
(from Christopher Lake)

Estimated response time 30 minutes

Waskesiu Fire Department requested by LDFD if necessary



### Forest Fire

Wildfires are the responsibility of the Saskatchewan Public

Safety Agency (SPSA) with nearest office in Prince Albert Local SPSA contact is Brent Krayetski at (306) 961-1496  
Many agencies will be involved in a wildfire event



### Medical Emergency

Estimated ambulance response time 1 hour

LDFD medical first responders are dispatched when a 911 call is placed with estimated response time 30 minutes

STARS Air Ambulance can be requested by Parkland Ambulance dispatch for events that meet strict criteria
